## Just the eNotary FAQs

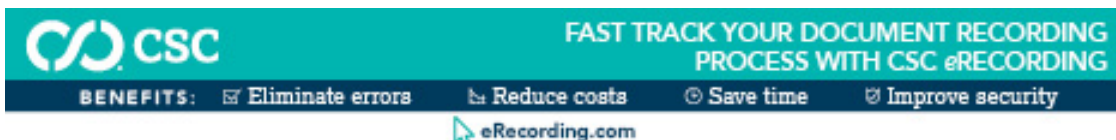
If you've got questions about eNotarization and RON, you need to mark your calendar for Thursday, January 19, from 3-4P ET.

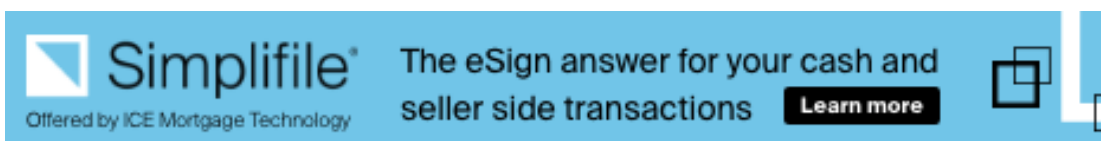


## It's Not Too Late to Volunteer
