North Carolina Moves Toward Ban on Ransomware Payments

The North Carolina House of Representatives on May 12 unanimously passed legislation that would prohibit state and local agencies from paying ransomware demands or

communicating with criminal actors who attempt to encrypt government networks or steal data. It would also increase the reporting requirements for covered organizations to inform the state Department of Information Technology (NCDIT) that they've been the victim of a ransomware incident.

Although the FBI routinely advises victims to never pay, many do. This bill also aims to bar negotiating with ransomware actors. "No state agency or local government entity shall submit payment or otherwise communicate with an entity that has engaged in a cybersecurity incident," it reads.

According to North Carolina state data, at least 37 ransomware attacks have been reported to NCDIT since 2016. NCDIT already has cyberattack regulations that require state and local agencies to report incidents that "result in a significant loss of data, system availability or control of systems" or affect critical infrastructure systems, among other symptoms within 24 hours of discovery.

While ransomware payments are broadly discouraged, there is little consensus on whether they should be banned outright, despite the North Carolina House's unanimous vote. A Ransomware Task Force made up of more than 60 industry experts stopped short of calling for a payment ban when it issued a detailed framework for combatting the threat, writing that doing so could provoke financially motivated criminal actors to simply look for other victims.



PRIA Board Approves Papers for 30-Day Comment

During the May 19 Board of Directors meeting, three papers were approved for 30-day comment.

The first paper is an updated version of the 2016 eRecording Best Practices for Recorders. There were enough changes made to the original document that the board determined a comment period was warranted.

The second and third papers are focused on ransomware. There is a Cybersecurity and Ransomware White Paper that provides background information and sets a knowledge-based level playing field. It includes current best practices to protect against an attack and procedures to follow when an organization is attacked by ransomware or other cybersecurity threat. A list of websites where you can find current information is included and sites are updated by their publishers (see Ransomware Resources in the website Resource Library).

A related paper on drafting a Service Level Agreement (SLA) walks the reader through the important components of an SLA including quality, availability and responsibilities which are agreed upon between the service provider and the service user. To create a solid SLA centered on backup and restoration (not circuits or software hosting), questions need to be answered and incorporated into a contract.
